Guidelines

Scholarships will be considered for the following:

-
- Voice
 - Instrumental Instruction
 - Conducting/ Teaching
 - Music Theory and Harmony

Qualifications for Graduate/Undergraduate Studies

-
- Applicant must be Greek Orthodox
 - Applicant may be a high school, undergraduate, or graduate student
 - Applicant may be a graduate advancing their knowledge of music
 - Applicant's Parish should be a member of the Federation for the current calendar year.

Application Procedures

-
- Each Application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation by your local priest and/or choir director.
 - Application must be postmarked no later than the September 15th deadline.
 - Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Selection of the winner is made by a majority vote of the Scholarship Committee
 - The Scholarship Committee will present the scholarships at the annual Choir Conference of the Metropolis of Boston Federation of Greek Orthodox Church Musicians, which is held in November.
